The summary should be typewritten/computer-generated on an $8-1/2 \times 11$ sheet(s).

Area III - Character (Up to 20 points awarded)

Please attach two personal recommendations. Give specific examples regarding character, dependability, involvement, and other distinguishing characteristics of the applicant. Recommendations must be typewritten/computer-generated on an $8-1/2 \times 11$ sheet(s).

Area IV – Academic (Up to 10 points awarded)

Please include an official transcript, including your cumulative GPA, from the last semester or quarter completed. If your cumulative GPA is not on your transcript, please attach it separately.
